


## Archetype



A universal pattern of consciousness, that orders parts of the human psyche into patterns of growth, patterns of questions, patterns of inner revelations. An archetypal pattern helps form and develops the psyche and brings spirit into the psyche. It's a way through which your ego and psyche (soul) meet and work together.

## **Distinctions - Archetypes**

#### E·go noun

- a person's sense of self-esteem or self-importance. "a boost to my ego" "the latest defeat was a bruise to my ego" "She is in her groove and has a lot of self-confidence"
- PSYCHOANALYSIS: the part of the mind that mediates between the conscious and the unconscious and is responsible for reality testing and a sense of personal identity.
- PHILOSOPHY: (in metaphysics) a conscious thinking subject.

#### Psy·che noun

- the human soul, mind, or spirit. "Their childhood made them want to understand the human psyche and to help others" "getting in touch with my psyche" "know thyself"
- synonyms: soul, spirit, inner self, true self, persona, subconscious, anima (Jung)




